

Ho, Leung, Ho and Lee Scholarship  
at St Hugh's College, Oxford  
2007-2010 or 2011

This scholarship will cover full overseas student fees for an undergraduate degree course.  
The fee levels for 2006-7 are as follows:-

Classics: Theology and Joint Schools	£8,880
Other Arts and Humanities courses	£10,360
Mathematics, Maths & Philosophy, Maths & Statistics	
All Science courses: Fine Art; and Music	£11,840

St Hugh's College will waive its overseas student fee, currently £4,820pa. The award holder will also receive a substantial annual grant towards travel and subsistence, the precise amount of which will vary from year to year. In all, the scholarship represents a total of £60,000 plus the values of the waived College fees.

The scholarship will be awarded on academic merit. It is open to all Hong Kong residents who have been accepted to read for an undergraduate degree at St Hugh's College, starting in October 2007 (see the website [www.st-hughs.ox.ac.uk](http://www.st-hughs.ox.ac.uk)). It may be held for the full duration – either 3 or 4 years – of the undergraduate degree course, subject to satisfactory academic progress.

The award of the scholarship – subject to the approval of the Trustees – will be made by a Committee chaired by the Principal of St Hugh's (Mr Andrew Dilnot, CBE)
